Tournament

The Swiss Open 2010 is the 3rd event of the 2010 PDGA EuroTour, A-tier.

The tournament is limited to 102 players and 6 wild cards for a maximum amount of 108 players.

The event will be played on an 27 holes course. Each regular round has 18 holes, Finals are played on 9 holes.

Registration The registration procedure is according to 2010 EuroTour Event Player Qualification & Registration guide lines.

The focus of the Swiss Open 2010 is on Pro players. The Swiss Open is open to all PDGA members from all over the world. All players (including amateurs) must be current PDGA members in order to play in the event.

Registration starts at January 15th, 2010.

Up to March 13rd 2010 (2 months prior to the Swiss Open) a part of the available 86 spots are reserved:

24 spots are reserved for PDGA Euro Pros (PDGA-rating of 950+) on a first come first serve basis.

10 spots are reserved for Pro Women on a first come first serve basis.

24 spots are reserved for Swiss Pro Division players with player ratings of 900+ (men) and 800+ (women) on a first come first serve basis.

12 spots are reserved for non-pro players, Amateurs (8 places) and Junior (4 places) players.

Your registration is confirmed once we received your payment.

Please note, that **after March 13th**, the rule "**first paid, first in**" applies for all registered players including the waiting list.

Doubles 1 round, 18 selected holes, best-shot with a partner of your choice.
Entry fee per pair: Euro 10 (CHF 15.-)
100% payout for 33% of the pairs.

Swiss Open 3 rounds (18 holes) for all players.

A final will be plaid for top 4 players in each division, top 8 for Pro Masters, and top 24 for Pro Open.

It will be plaid more or less like the Stockholm Open:

72 players from the same divisions will play 18 different holes at every round (1 to 18, 10 to 27 and 19 to 9), and the other 36 players will play 9 holes twice each round (1 to 9 twice, 10 to 18, 19 to 27).

The groups and the schedule will be available latest one week before the tournament on the web site.

- Division** The divisions will only be run if there are 4 or more players.

- Please remember that all players must be current PDGA members in order to register and play in the event. If you do not yet have a PDGA membership, please contact your national PDGA Country Coordinator.
- Entry Fees** Pro Division: € 75.- (CHF 113.-)
Amateurs: € 55.- (CHF 83.-)
Juniors: € 50.- (CHF 75.-)
- Fee includes the player's package (gift, 2 drinks, 2 snacks or fruit), sat/sun breakfasts, free entry at the spa of Cressy (don't forget you swim gear).
- Payment** You confirm your registration by paying **only your entry fee** until **13th march 2010** using **PayPal**. Each registered player will receive an E-mail with a PayPal money request.

- The fee will be increased by € 5.-- after this date.
Your registration will be confirmed only when we receive your payment.
- Other Fees** Sat and Sunday Lunches (€ 9.--/day), player's dinner (€ 18.--), dormitory (€ 12.--/night), ace pool (€ 3.--).
To be paid at the final registration at the organization tent.
- Prize money** The prize money is minimum € 5'000.-- for Pro's only. The prize money will be divided among the best 33% of the field in all Pro divisions (if four or more players enter the division).
- Final purse will be announced on Sunday (info board).
- Trophies** Pro Open Winner will receive the golden disc trophy.
- Other Pro winners will receive trophies or other prizes.
- Amateurs and Juniors will be competing for trophies or other prizes.
- Other special prizes will be distributed for other games (hole-in-one pool, closest-to-the-pin,...)

Lodging & Eating

Geneva offers a wide range of hotels and restaurant. Below please find our recommendations.

Lodging



A big **dormitory** (60 spots) is available directly on the course.

First registered, first served ! Price is €12.-- per night, from thursday to sunday night included, if you need.

Do not forget your sleeping bag.

For those who wants more quiet and comfort, you can go to **IBIS hotel** near the airport (approx. 15 minutes away from the course by car). It is possible to book rooms at the following number +41 22 710 95 00 or by e-mail to the following address: h3535@accor.com
If you do so please mention " Group booking for Disc Golf " and bring either your PDGA membership card or a "Print Screen" of your registration form. The price is approx CHF 90.- (€ 60.--) from friday to saturday, and CHF 149.- the other days, for a double room. The breakfast and the parking are not included.

You can also stay at the hotel **Formule 1** close to the airport, in Ferney (France) (tél. (+33) 450 40 46 84). Price: € 31.--. There is another Formule 1 a bit closer to the course, in St-Julien (France). Price: € 30.-- (tél. (+33)891 70 52 55). No shuttle service is provided.

Eating

The meals included in the player's package:

- 2 snacks & 2 drinks
- Breakfast saturday (07:30 – 09:00) and Sunday (07:00 – 08:30) in the room at the first floor.

Not-included: Lunches Saturday and Sunday at € 8.-- (salads, bread, pasta, meat & others we'll be available).

Thursday is holiday, so some of the restaurants and the big shops will be closed in the area (except gas stations and the Pizzeria "L'Onesienne", rue du Vieux Moulin 14).

Others restaurants at 10mn walk: "La Ferme" (route de Chancy 132) or the cafeteria from Coop shopping center (rue des Bossons 21).

Players Dinner

Player's dinner on Saturday evening: a meal is organized at the restaurant of the center for €18.-- / CHF 30.- at 7pm. For those sleeping out of the center, you can take a shower at the sports center.
