Tournament

The Swiss Open 2011 is the 3rd event of the PDGA EuroTour, A-tier.

The tournament is limited to 100 players and 8 wild cards for a maximum amount of 108 players.

The event will be played on an 27 holes course. Each regular round has 18 holes, finals are played on 9 holes. The course is similar to 2010, no major changes.

Registration The registration procedure is according to 2011 EuroTour Event Player Qualification & Registration guide lines.

The focus of the Swiss Open 2011 is on Pro players. The Swiss Open is open to all PDGA members from all over the world. All players (including amateurs) must be current PDGA members in order to play in the event.

Registration starts on february 3rd, 2011.

Up to april 3rd, 2011 (2 months prior to the Swiss Open) a part of the available 100 spots are reserved:

Stage 1, to begin on feb 3rd, 2011: MPO currently rated 975+, FPO rated 900+, MPM rated 950+, MPG rated 925+, MPS rated 875+, MJ1 rated 925+.

Stage 2, begins feb. 17th, 2011: MPO currently rated 940+, FPO rated 825+, MPM rated 900+, MPG rated 875+, MPS rated 825+, MJ1 rated 875+.

Stage 3, begins march 3rd, 2011: All other players.

10 spots are reserved for Pro Women players

Your registration is confirmed once we received your payment.

Please note, that **after april 3rd**, the rule "**first paid, first in**" applies for all registered players including the waiting list.

Doubles 1 round, 18 selected holes, best-shot, with a partner of your choice.
Divisions : open and mixed
Entry fee per pair: CHF 15.--
100% payout for top 4 pairs (open) and top 33% for mixed division.

Swiss Open 3 rounds (18 holes) for all players.
A final will be plaid for top 4 players in each division, top 8 for Pro Masters, and top 24 for Pro Open.

It will be plaid like the Stockholm Open:
72 players from the same divisions will play 18 different holes at every round (1 to 18, 10 to 27 and 19 to 9), and the other 36 players will play 9 holes twice each round (1 to 9 twice, 10 to 18, 19 to 27).

The groups and the schedule will be available latest one week before the tournament on the web site.

Divisions The following divisions are offered for Registration:

Pro Open (MPO)
Pro Woman (FPO)
Pro Masters (MPM)
Pro Grandmasters (MPG)
Amateurs Open (AM1)
Juniors (MpJ)

Please remember that all players must be current PDGA members in order to register and play in the event. If you do not yet have a PDGA membership, please contact your national PDGA Country Coordinator.

Entry Fees Every amount is in Swiss Francs

Pro Division: CHF 100.--
Amateurs: CHF 75.--
Juniors: CHF 65.--

Fee includes the player's package (gift, 2 drinks, 2 snacks or fruit), sat/sun breakfasts, and the welcome drinks & snacks

Payment You confirm your registration by paying **only your entry fee** until **april 3rd, 2011**. Each registered player will receive an E-mail with a PayPal money request.

The fee will be increased by CHF 10.-- after this date.

Your registration will be confirmed only when we receive your payment.

Other Fees Saturday and Sunday Lunches (CHF 12.--/day), player's dinner (CHF 26.--), dormitory (CHF 20.--/night), ace pool (CHF 5.--).
To be paid at the final registration at the organization desk.

Spa of Cressy's entry is CHF 10.-- (don't forget your swim gear).

Prize money The prize money is minimum CHF 7'000.-- for Pro's only (more than € 5'000.--). The prize money will be divided among the best 33% of the field in all Pro divisions (if 4 or more players enter the division).

Final purse will be announced at latest on Sunday (info board).

Trophies Pro Open Winner will receive the golden disc trophy.

Other Pro winners will receive trophies or other prizes.
Amateurs and Juniors will be competing for trophies or other prizes.

Other special prizes will be distributed for other games (hole-in-one pool, closest-to-the-pin, Trophée Gouge...)

Lodging & Eating

Geneva offers a wide range of hotels and restaurant. Below please find our recommendations.

Lodging



A big **dormitory** (60 spots) is available directly on the course.

First registered, first served ! Price is CHF 20.-- per night, from thursday to sunday night included, if you need.

Do not forget your sleeping bag.

For those who wants more quiet and comfort, you can go to the new IBIS hotel near the course (approx. 5 minutes away by car, or 2 bus stops and 10mn walk). It is possible to book rooms at the following number +41 22 709 02 00 or by e-mail: h7289@accor.com .

If you do so please mention " Group booking for Disc Golf " and the reservation Nr 166236. The price is CHF 89.-- from friday to Saturday (plus CHF 2,55 tax per person per day), and CHF 119.- the other days, for a double room. The breakfast and the parking are not included (CHF 15.-- per day each). There's only 7 twin rooms, and 3 doubles for couples. **The twins rooms are already booked since Feb. 23th.**

If the IBIS is overbooked, you can try the Etap Hotel the next door, it's the same Accor group, they have 2 and 3 bed rooms for CHF 89.--, but the comfort is lower and the triple is with a big bed + another up. Or you can try the former **IBIS** near the airport (No shuttle service provided and it's approx. 15 minutes away from the course by car). It is possible to book rooms at the following number +41 22 710 95 00 or by e-mail to the following address: h3535@accor.com .

You can also stay at the hotel **Formule 1** close to the airport, in Ferney (France) tel. (+33) 450 40 46 84. Price: € 31.--. There is another Formule 1 a bit closer to the course, in St-Julien (France). Price: € 30.-- tel. (+33)891 70 52 55. No shuttle service is provided.

Eating

The meals included in the player's package:

- Welcome drink & snack
- 2 snacks & 2 drinks
- Breakfast saturday (07:30 – 09:00) and Sunday (07:00 – 08:30) in the room at the first floor.

Not-included: Lunches Saturday and Sunday for CHF 12.-- (salads, bread, pasta, meat & others we'll be available).

Thursday is holiday, so some of the restaurants and the big shops will be closed in the area (except gas stations and the Pizzeria "L'Onesienne", rue du Vieux Moulin 14).

Others restaurants at 10mn walk: "La Ferme" (route de Chancy 132) or the cafeteria from Coop shopping center (rue des Bossons 21).

Players Dinner

Player's dinner on Saturday evening: a meal is organized at the restaurant of the sport center for CHF 26.-- at 7pm. For those sleeping out of the center, you can take a shower at the sports center.

Book it together with your on-line registration. We would be glad to spend the evening all together.

So, you can sign up latest when you confirm your inscription at the organization tent. But be informed that we'll refuse cancellations and refund after this !
